



Step 1: Your Disconnect

Your disconnect should be set in the 'On' position as shown below. Whatever word you can read upright ('On' or 'Off'), is the position the switch is in. If it's off, pull the handle, flip it upside down & return it to its housing.

This may require some force, so be careful but also firm with this.

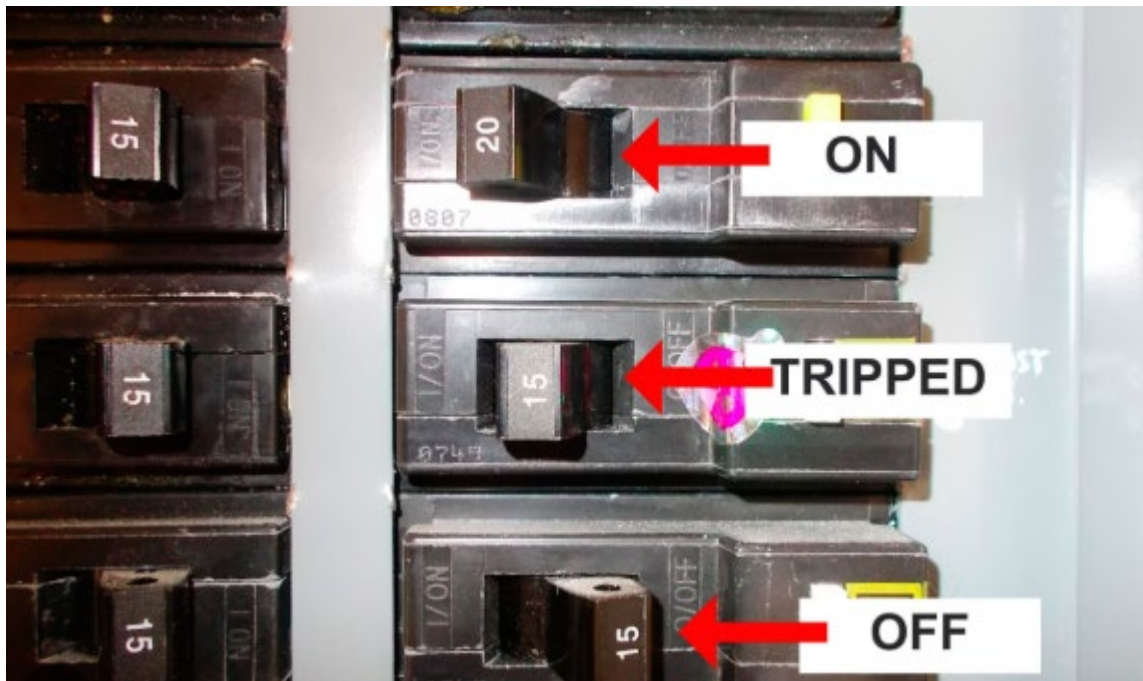

Step 2: Your Breaker

Be sure that your AC electrical breaker in the panel is flipped to the 'on' position. If the breaker is off, turn it on. If it's tripped, you'll have to turn it off, then you can flip it to the 'on' position.



Step 3: The Thermostat

Be sure your thermostat has a display & the setting is set to 'cool'.



Step 4: Your Filter

Be sure your furnace filters are not dirty or need to be changed. These filters should be changed regularly, especially with pets, allergies or home renovation that may cause extra air pollution.
